







Director's Statement

Clint Eastwood's 'The Man With No Name' is solidified as the definitive gunslinger of the West. It is time for a new sharp-shooter, but she does have a name - Grace Malone. A bounty hunter who prefers her bounties dead than alive!

'Fall From Grace' is a female-centric modern take on the Spaghetti Westerns from the '60s & '70s. It centres around a family drama, where a father's secrets from the past have enormous repercussions on the life of his daughter. The choices she's left with, force her to question her desire for and the consequences of revenge. The film tackles universal themes of loss, retribution and redemption. Our goal is to make an entertaining film in the vein of 'The Dollars Trilogy', while shining a light on the harsh realities of 1880's America - illustrating the struggles, challenges and triumphs of the underrepresented of that time.

'The Good, The Bad & The Ugly' is synonymous with those three character-types. In 'Fall From Grace' our characters are all three and more! Showing dark, light and varying shades of grey in their personalities, we showcase their need for survival. After all, we all make good, bad and ugly choices.

The characters in 'Fall From Grace' don't live in the duality of good and bad. For this reason, we will be bringing a noir feel to heighten that feeling of uncertainty and struggle through the Jungian shadow of personality.

In a genre where the avenging is always delivered by hired men, (Once Upon A Time in The West, True Grit, Jane Got A Gun), our heroine Grace is more than capable of serving her revenge ice cold. A bullet doesn't discriminate!



Vignal Statement

There is almost a level of poetry in the awakening of moral consciousness in the Old West. A mixture of romanticism, danger and human nature that load individuals with raw emotion and high stakes.

It is for those reasons that an incredible amount of thought and consideration has gone into the visual language of 'Fall From Grace'. The connection among characters on screen, the alignment of emotion with lighting and the narrative of camera movement will be paramount.

'Fall From Grace' will be led by performances, with the stunning landscape supporting the rich characters and narrative.

The picture will be presented in the iconic widescreen CinemaScope format and we will use the tones and colours produced by classic film negatives.

With the use of anamorphic lenses, we will get up close and personal with the lead characters whilst still connecting them to the context of their environment.

With the use of chiaroscuro and natural volumetric lighting, we will bring the nuance, complexity and duality of the characters to the screen, solidifying the concept of the Jungian shadow of personality.






































